WHO SHOULD RECEIVE THE OVERALL ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD?

Many school awards acknowledge students' achievements within a particular area in the class room, on the sports fields or in the community. As its name suggests, the Overall Academic Award recognises a student whose achievements span the area of academic excellence in classroom academic endeavour. The winner is characterised by their achieving the highest result in classroom academic endeavour for their year level.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The student will come from the Year 6 cohort each year
- The student will be selected by a committee made up of the current Year 6 teachers and the Principal
- The criteria below will be considered in selecting the Overall Academic Awardee:

Academic – The results from the following Academic Test Items will be considered in making the decision:

- Individual PAT Scale Scores in Year 6 PAT Reading and PAT Maths Testing
- Individual Classroom Subject Ratings in English, Maths, Science, History and Geography in Semester 1 and 2 from the final year of school
