

## Sports Awards Criteria

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### WHO SHOULD WIN THESE AWARDS?

Many school awards acknowledge students' achievements within a particular area in the class room, on the sports fields or in the community. As their names suggest, the **Sportsman and Sportswomen Awards** are awarded to those students who have gained the highest cumulative representation over the course of a school year in Queensland Primary School Sporting competitions. These awards are given based on accumulated points for each level of representation.

- State Representation – 10 points
- Regional Representation (Capricornia) – 5 points
- Mackay and District Representation – 3 points
- Southern Suburbs Representation – 2 points
- School Representation – 1 point

The **Sportsperson of the Year** is not necessarily the person who achieves the most points over the school sporting season. The following criteria are used to determine the Sportsperson of the Year.

### SPORTSPERSON OF THE YEAR

This award is presented to the student/athlete who:

- shows leadership, dedication and spirit both in sports and in school
- displays sportsperson like conduct on and off the playing area
- shows respect for the coach, referee and his/her teammates
- shows a positive example to their teammates through play and attitude
- is in good standing with good school behaviour

Bronze Awards – These certificates are presented to students who are members of a Southern Suburbs Team and attended Mackay and District Trials.

Silver Awards - These certificates are presented to students who are members of a Mackay and District Team and attended Capricornia Trials.

Gold Awards - Silver Awards - These certificates are presented to students who are members of Capricornia Team and attended State Trials.
