Year 5 All Rounder Award

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WHO SHOULD RECEIVE THE YEAR 5 ALL ROUNDER AWARD?

Many school awards acknowledge students' achievements within a particular area in the class room, on the sports fields or in the community. As its name suggests, the All Rounder Award recognises a student whose achievements span a number of areas including academic studies, sport, cultural, community work, conduct and potential leadership. Winners are characterised by their commitment to doing their best in all their pursuits, setting an outstanding example and assisting their peers and others.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The student will come from the Year 5 cohort each year
- The student will be selected by a committee made up of the current Year 5 teachers, one Specialist teacher (either HPE, Music, LOTE, Librarian or Learning Support teacher) and the Principal
- The criteria below will be considered in selecting the All Rounder Awardee:

Academic - achieves scholastically across a range of subjects

Attitude - is committed to excellence, willing to help others, makes selfless contributions

Conduct - is exemplary at all times

Leadership - is a role model to other students and has potential to become a student leader in Year 6

Service - participates in school and community activities

Sport - represents the school without necessarily being a champion

Cultural – represents the school without necessarily being an outstanding performer
