

# Annual Sports Awards Criteria

## WHO SHOULD WIN THESE AWARDS?

Many school awards acknowledge students' achievements within a particular area in the classroom, on the sports fields or in the community. As its name suggests, the **sportsman and sportswomen awards** are awarded to those students who have gained the highest cumulative representation over the course of a school year in Queensland Primary School Sporting competitions. These awards are given based on accumulated points for each level of representation.

- State Representation - 10 points
- Regional Representation (Capricornia) – 5 points
- Mackay and District Representation – 3 points
- Southern Suburbs Representation – 2 points
- School Representation – 1 point.

The Sportsperson of the Years is not necessarily the person who achieves the most points over the school sporting season. The following criteria are used to determine the Sportsperson of the Year.

**Bronze Awards** – These certificates are presented to students who are members of a Southern Suburbs Team and attend Mackay and District Trials.

**Silver Awards** - These certificates are presented to students who are members of a Mackay and District Team and attend Capricornia Trials.

**Gold Awards - Silver Awards** - These certificates are presented to students who are members of Capricornia Team and attend State Trials.

## SPORTSPERSON OF THE YEAR

This award is presented to the student/athlete who:

- shows leadership, dedication and spirit both in sports and in school.
- displays sportsperson like conduct on and off the playing area.
- shows respect for the coach, referee and his/her teammates.
- shows a positive example to their teammates through play and attitude.
- is in good standing with good school behaviour.
