

OVERALL ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD

WHO SHOULD RECEIVE THE OVERALL ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD?

Many school awards acknowledge students' achievements within a particular area in the class room, on the sports fields or in the community. As its name suggests, the Overall Academic Excellence Award recognises a student whose achievements span the area of academic excellence in classroom academic endeavour. The Winner is characterised by their achieving the highest result in classroom academic endeavour.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- The student will come from the Year 6 cohort each year.
- The student will be selected by a committee made up of the current Year 6 teachers and the Principal
- The criteria below will be considered in selecting the Overall Academic Excellence Awardee:

Academic – The results from the following Academic Test Item will be considered in making the decision:

- Individual Scale Scores in Yr 7 NAPLAN (practice test from current year) results in all 5 strands Reading, Writing, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation and Numeracy
- Individual PAT Scale Scores in Yr 6 PAT Reading and PAT Maths Testing
- Individual Classroom Subject Ratings in English Maths, Science, History and Geography in Semester 1 and 2 from the final year of school.
