
CLASS AWARDS – ACADEMIC, CITIZENSHIP AND NORTH STAR

RATIONALE

Typically, awards are presented to recognize outstanding scholarship, or service to the institution; to recognize and encourage student participation at school; to encourage a particular kind of scholarship, or service; and the like.

CLASS AWARDS - YEAR PREP, ONE, TWO

Students from Years Prep, 1 and 2 will have awards presented to them in the form of a certificate that will highlight a personal characteristic that has been able to be identified. eg Sensational Reader, Mr Helpful, Class Problem solver, etc.



Awards will be presented to students at an afternoon ceremony/celebration which can occur in the afternoon or twilight part of an evening on a school day.

CLASS AWARDS - YEARS THREE, FOUR, FIVE AND SIX

Students from Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will be nominated by their classroom teacher for an award from one of the three school categories – Academic, Citizenship, North Star.

Any combination of the classroom awards can be presented to the students. – see criteria below

SELECTION CRITERIA

The award categories –

Class Academic Awards -

This will be evidenced by:

- Students should have not less than a "B" in English and Mathematics in each Semester.
- Students must have an "A" in English or Mathematics in each Semester.
- Students should have not less than a "B" in Science and HASS.
- Students should have not less than a "C" in the other Learning Areas – LOTE, HPE, Music, The Arts and Technology.
- Students should have not less than a "Satisfactory" for effort ratings in all Learning Areas.

This will be Verified by:

- Within year level moderation
- Report Card rating on Semester One and Two formal reports

Student numbers -

 all students who meet the above criteria will be presented with Academic Award

Class Citizenship Awards -

- This will be evidenced by:
- Obeying the school rules,
- Being considerate of others in the school,
- Caring for the school environment,
- Demonstrating a sense of loyalty to the school,
- Respecting the rights of others

This will be Verified by:

- Class helper records
- Behaviour data
- Communications books
- Participation in school and community events records

Class North Star Awards -

- This will be evidenced by:
- Students who deserve to be recognised but tend to miss out because they are overshadowed by the high flyers.
- "The triers".

This will be Verified by:

- Consistent academic results (not necessarily high)
- Behaviour Records
- Cultural Data
- Sporting Data
- Communication book Data

Student Numbers -

■ The total number of students who may receive North Star or Citizenship awards must be not more than 20% of class population. (approximately 4 students per class)

Teacher discretion can be used to determine the mix of North Star and Citizenship award.
